- ✓ Set goals with my child and develop a reward system.
- ✓ Find an appropriate time to read with my child.
- ✓ Supply a variety of reading materials with the local library as a source.

- ✓ Have my child arrive at school on time.
- ✓ Have my child attend school regularly so that he/she can access Title 1 services.
- ✓ Work with the school to make decisions about my child's education.
