Dear Parent:


The federal legislation known as the “No Child Left Behind” (NCLB) was signed into law in January 2002. This law requires schools that receive Title I funding to inform parents of their right to know the following information about each child’s classroom teachers:

- Whether the state has qualified or licensed the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches
- Whether he or she is teaching under an emergency permit or other provisional status through which the licensing criteria have been waived
- The teacher’s college major, whether the teacher has any advanced degrees, and, if so, the subject of the degrees
- Whether any instructional aides or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your child, and, if they do, their qualifications
