Steps in the SAP Process

Referral

- •Forms completed by the SAP Community.
- •All referrals are secure.
- •All referrals made to SAP are confidential.

Team Planning

- Team members and parents work togeher.
- Determine a supportive and appropriate plan for the student.

Intervention

- A plan is developed based on the student strengths.
- The plan is put into action.

Follow-Up

- The SAP team continues to work and support the student and family.
- The team will monitor, mentor, and motivate the student for success.
